Abstract:

This collection documents the work of Ann Baker (1936-2016), an abortion rights and LGBTQ+ activist. A resident of New Jersey, she was active in state and federal politics, and was involved in many local and national organizations promoting access to abortion and equality for LGBTQ+ couples. The bulk of this material pertains to Baker's work collecting, documenting and disseminating information relating to the anti-abortion movement in the 1980s-1990s, in particular her work tracking Operation Rescue and other militant anti-abortion organizations. Baker's papers contain periodicals and other publications, correspondence, photographs, clippings and audiovisual materials, which document the anti-abortion movement and the pro-abortion movement's responses. Baker was in contact with organizers, clinics, abortion providers, as well as national anti-abortion and pro-abortion organizations. This collection includes graphic images of fetuses and babies. In some cases, the presence of such materials has been noted at the folder level; however, not every instance was identified.

Background

Scope and Content

Ann Baker's collection consists of research, printed materials, and correspondence documenting her work for the National Center for the Pro Choice Majority (originally named The 80% Majority); the National Organization for Women (NOW); Planned Parenthood; National Abortion Federation (NAF); National Abortion Rights Action League (NARAL); and other pro-abortion organizations and movements throughout the United States during the 1970s through the early 2000s. The collection's research and subject files document various organizations, individuals, and topics relating to women's rights and healthcare access; birth control and reproductive rights; abortion (including safe and legal access to abortion; proposed legislation and ongoing litigation in various regions; activities and movements of anti-abortion militants like Randall Terry and Joe Scheidler; police records of abortion protestors; pro-choice organizations and administration; and oppositional research on pro-life movements and tactics, such as picketing and demonstrations, threats of and instances of violence, and promotion of pregnancy crisis centers and distribution of misleading abortion literature).

The collection also documents Baker's interest and involvement in local and national political campaigns, LGBTQ+ family law and equality, and education. Along with national abortion rights issues, Baker's collection documents her work with the Family Equality Coalition, and local New Jersey political and community campaigns she participated in during the 1970s through 2010s. The collection's contents have been described largely as Baker initially developed and used the collection, and consist of Research and Organization Files sorted by geography, title, or topic.

The Printed Materials Series contains Baker's collected issues and titles of various anti-abortion and pro-abortion organizational newsletters, as well as monographs and other published works from her library. Many of these correlate to Research and Subject Files also contained within the collection. Audiovisual Materials are a mixture of commercially-produced anti-abortion recordings, some of conferences and organizations, as well as news coverage and interviews with members of various anti-abortion and pro-abortion organizations.

This collection contains images of fetuses, deceased babies, documentation of violence, and other graphic content. In some cases, the presence of such materials has been noted at the folder level; however, not every instance was identified.

Biographical/Historical

Ann Baker was born in Salem, Ohio in 1936. A women's rights, reproductive rights and LGBT activist, she served on the National Organization for Women's Reproductive Rights Committee, and was the founder and director of the National Center for the Pro Choice Majority.

Baker, prior to founding the NCPCM, worked as a high school history teacher in Ohio and New York, before working as the Catholic Campus Minister at the College of New Jersey. In the 1970s, she began working with the New Jersey branch of NOW. In 1987, she founded the 80% Majority, a clearinghouse for information related to abortion clinic violence, attacks against providers and perpetrator information. The organization was based in Roosevelt, New Jersey, and was renamed the National Center for the Pro Choice Majority (NCPCM) in January 1993. The NCPCM published The Campaign Report, bi-weekly newsletter that provided updates and information on clinic blockades and the anti-abortion movement. This newsletter was mailed across the country to clinics and other pro-choice organizations.

Realizing there was no centralized organization to track anti-abortion protestors, Baker compiled lists and photographs of these protestors as they staged and led demonstrations at different clinics across the US. By collecting and cross-referencing arrest lists, Baker was able to prove it was the same group of clinic protestors, which led to increased legal fees and jail time for repeat offenders. To conduct this work, she collected a vast array of clippings, photographs, publications and correspondence, as well as research on claims made by the anti-abortion movement, such as "post-abortion syndrome".

Baker developed a wide array of contacts in different parts of the country and internationally. Often, these contacts provided information on the anti-choice movements (including events, literature and press coverage), as well as reports of their experiences with the anti-choice movement. She was well respected by clinic operators for her work and developed a deep network of contacts.

In the early 2000s, Baker turned her attention to equal rights for gay and lesbian couples, founding the Family Equality Commission to advocate for rights for LGBT couples in her state of New Jersey. She served as a committeewoman in her town of Roosevelt and was an activist in local Democratic politics.

This collection was received in boxes of various size, although many materials were in folders with titles. Folders were removed from boxes and rehoused in archival folders and Paige boxes. Folder titles were retained and grouped into intellectual series and sub-series. For materials that were loose in the boxes, some items were housed in folders created by the processing archivist, while others were rehoused in archival folders with minimal processing. These folders were then interfiled intellectually with original folders. Baker used the terms "Pro-Life" and "Pro-Choice" to describe the anti-abortion and pro-abortion movements.

Scope and Contents

The Research Files series contains five subseries: Topical Research Files, Geographic Research Files, Operation Rescue Research Files, Litigation Research Files and Legislative Research Files. Dates on folders are indicative of when materials was produced. In the case of clippings, dates refer to the original date on the clipping, not when the clipping was duplicated.

The bulk of Baker's research files are housed in the General Research Files subseries. The bulk of this material concerns reproductive health and

associated topics. Many of these research files focus on claims made by anti-abortion organizations, as well as Baker's documentation of direct-action tactics used during illegal demonstrations. Also contains her research files about various prominent anti-abortion leaders, names and photographs of clinic demonstrators, records of instances of violence and harassment, as well as information on various organizations Baker tracked during her research. Files may contain correspondence, printed material, photographs, clippings and notes and marginalia produced by Baker throughout the course of her research. These files also include materials relating to federal elections, Baker's activism work in New Jersey and Catholicism. These files have been arranged alphabetically, with legal sized files interfiled intellectually into the series.

Geographic Research Files are organized by location, and document state laws that impact access to reproductive health. Includes information on state Medicaid status, as well as extensive material from reproductive rights organizations in Canada, such as Canadian Abortion Rights Action League (CARAL). These materials are organized by state and city where applicable.

The Operation Rescue Research Files: Arrest Records and Clippings by City contain information compiled by Baker during her work tracking Operation Rescue's demonstrations across the United States. Arranged by Baker, these are organized by city and contain clippings and arrest lists used to identify anti-abortion activists as they traveled around the country demonstrating. It also includes correspondence with clinics and providers, who often sent information to Baker about their encounters with Operation Rescue, as well as flyers and brochures produced by Operation Rescue leading up to their demonstrations. This material contains sensitive, personally identifying information about Operation Rescue members. See restriction note for more information.

The Email Printout subseries contains copies of emails from various reproductive rights groups Baker was a part of in the late 1990s and early 2000s. Arranged by listserv and by month, these emails depict conversation between providers and activists working against anti-abortion protestors. Some of these emails can be found filed by Baker in the research files series. Includes emails from the Biblical America Resistance Front (barf.org), as well as Women's Clinic Defense listserv and other pro-abortion organizations.

The Litigation Files subseries contains information relating to court cases impacting abortion access. These are filed according to topics as determined by Baker, such as fake abortion clinics, cases relating to the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances (FACE) Act, Supreme Court cases impacting access, as well as state cases. Files include clippings, copies of depositions and rulings and notes, and marginalia produced by Baker during the course of her research.

The Legislative Files subseries documents federal elections, voting records of members of Congress, testimony given in Congress, and other material

relating to abortion and the legislature. Files may include clippings, copies of testimonies, and marginalia produced by Baker during her research.

The Printed Materials series contains four subseries: Serials, Reports and Handbooks, Books and Pamphlets, and Ephemera.

The Serials subseries contains copies of Baker's newsletters, The Campaign Report and The ProChoice Report. It also includes the publications of many anti-abortion organizations, including Advocates for Life, National Right to Life and Focus on the Family. The subseries includes publications from pro-abortion organizations such as Planned Parenthood and the National Abortion Federation. Files may include marginalia or tipped in items added by Baker during the course of her research. These materials are arranged alphabetically by the name of the producing organization, title of publication and by date. Additional serials may be found in the Research Files subseries.

The Reports and Handbooks subseries includes monographic reports and handbooks produced by various organizations including the ACLU, the Alan Guttmacher Institute, the National Abortion Federation, National Organization of Women (NOW), and National Right to Life. Some items may include marginalia or tip ins added by Baker during her research. These materials are organized by organization and then date.

The Printed Ephemera subseries is comprised of assorted printed items collected throughout the course of processing the collection. The bulk of the anti-abortion ephemera was housed loose in one box and labeled as such by Baker. Please note, some the anti-abortion ephemera contains graphic images of deceased fetuses.

The Books and Pamphlets subseries is comprised of books from Baker's personal library and pamphlets produced by various organizations. These materials include inscriptions to Baker, tip ins and marginalia produced by Baker. This subseries is housed unfolded in a record carton box.
