Her photographs include community events and activities such as hog butchering, church services, family reunions, and gatherings of charity groups. The Rosenwald Schools series contains approximately 300 color digital images of schools for African Americans built during the first half of the 20th century through the Rosenwald foundation, as well as some portraits of former students in Kentucky, North Carolina and Alabama. The Homeplace series contains 250 11x14 inch silver gelatin black-and-white prints documenting Hoskins' visits and relationships with rural African American communities in Kentucky, originally established by freedmen in the 19th century. Her photographs include community events and activities such as hog butchering, church services, family reunions, and gatherings of charity groups.

The Rosenwald Schools series contains approximately 300 color digital images of schools for African Americans built during the first half of the 20th century through the Rosenwald foundation, as well as portraits of some former students in Kentucky, North Carolina and Alabama. The series also includes images of a Rosenwald foundation-funded apartment building in Chicago, Illinois.

### **The Homeplace, 2000-2014**

**Physical Description:** 3.0 Linear Feet (250) 11x14" Silver Gelatin Prints in 5 flat boxes.

#### **Scope and Contents**

The Homeplace documents the traditions and daily lives of African American communities in Kentucky's Inner Bluegrass region that were originally founded by freed slaves following the Civil War. As Hoskins states:

"Today many of the residents are descendants of the freed men and women who founded these hamlets. In some cases as many as six generations of a family have lived in succession on a "homeplace" in these communities. Some of these hamlets are prospering while the existence of others is tenuous."

The Homeplace documents events such as hog butchering; harvesting and drying tobacco; worship services at community churches; service group meetings, such as the Union Benevolent Society Lodge; creekside baptisms; and family reunions, meals, and gatherings. Each print has been assigned an RL ID and includes Hoskins' original title and caption.

The first visit was back in the fall of 2001. I remember as it was my first trip after 9/11 in October. The school was empty and in disrepair. The Cadentown Baptist Church which was in front to the school had been sold and had been made into a private residence. Back

on that first visit on a early Sunday morning I knocked on the door. There was no answer, I ignored the No Trespassing signs and went around to the back and photographed the school (though I did not know anything about Rosenwald Schools at the time). I also photographed the outhouse but was most intrigued by the cemetery as it was in a strange state. There were red flags posted next to the grave stones and it just felt odd. It wasn't until the next spring that I learned of all the controversy. Apparently the people who bought the church and made it a home did not welcome people visiting the old cemetery and there was talk of moving it. The owners had put a fence up towards the front of their home which is where the signs were the no trespassing signs were posted. I heard stories that it turned pretty nasty. My friend Jonetta Young and her mother Helen who lived down the road in Cadentown fought for a long time to save the school and cemetery as well as halt a new white church that was being built. The white church was across the street from their home and the school. The building of the new church caused flooding to theirs and neighboring homes. Also the white church was tearing up old grave sites. Jonetta hired a "cadaver dog" and the story made the Herald Leader,( the Lexington paper.) I know that I have images of old grave stones that were moved. Kind of like the movie Poltergeist. The new white church eventually went up. The graves paved over for a parking lot. Jonetta moved away with her mother Helen who I heard got Alzheimer's and passed away. She was a lovely woman whose Birthday was close to mine. We always sent Birthday cards and it was Jonetta and Helen Young who introduced me to the Howard sisters. Helen Young had been a student at the Cadentown school, her teacher had been Lena Mae Howard. First I could not believe the location I had never been or photographed a Rosenwald so tucked in and low. Down, down in a long valley at the base near pretty much near nothing. It seemed so out of place as did I getting there. Maybe it was the fact that it was further south then I had been since the car accident maybe the fact that the roads leading to it were insane. Maybe it was meeting a huge pickup coming out of the mud on a road on a blind curve that was barely a lane next to a creek. I visualized the dully truck the rebel flag waving running me off and into the creek. A lone cow in the middle of the road around a bend. You get the idea. Then as the road ends and T's. There it sits. I don't know that I have ever been as stunned to see a Rosenwald school, still there, still standing in a valley so low I didn't know that we would get out of there alive. Not to mention the Pit Bull and the gun shots from the inside of the school, but what a reward finding it. I have also

included some of the roads leading to the school. How can you not include a lane called Sad Lane."

Hoskins writes: "When I first went to Hootentown back in 2003 to try and locate this black hamlet I learned about the church and school. My friend Betty Smithers from the hamlet of Jonestown was with me. We saw the sign marked Hootentown Lane, but the turn and lane where so tight and straight up we had to turn around and come back at it. We then realized it was too steep to come in that way and had to turn around again. Finally we headed up and in. There was a split as you drove up the lane and we took the one to the right. It dead ended at the top of the hill. Two large big burly white men, an older woman and a middle age woman and two kids were there. We were pretty much stuck as the road ended into their trailer. Betty rolls down the window and says, " We're here looking for the black hamlets. " I figured this was it , the guns were being loaded. Then the middle aged woman named Cheryl Bryant says, "well honey I am the blackest thing out here come on out." She said we were lucky we didn't take the other lane or he would have started shooting. She showed us how to locate old grave stones by looking for honey suckle plants. We found some from the old hamlet and then she told us about the church down below. " I sometimes go sit behind my trailer on the side of the hill and listen to them singing on Sunday." She pointed the way and told us how to go out and quickly turn left. That is how I first came to this school. We had completely missed the lane to the church. We found our way into the lane and over the single lane bridge that led to the church. I held my breath as we crossed over it hoping we would make it to the other side. I felt sure I felt it sway. We pulled into and onto the gravel and there was a car parked. It was a Saturday. I walked up and could hear a vacuum cleaner running and knocked. That was how I met Bobby Hart. He showed us in and around and when I asked about the small building behind the church he said, "It was an old school, someone from Sears built it." I have spoken with the Rosenwald Foundation and they feel it is the Jouett's Creek school. The photos match up, it had been listed in the wrong location. As of 2012 there is a sign that says Jouett's Creek Lane up the road, which helps confirm it is correct. I am sure this is right.

For whatever reason it was a welcome surprise to be welcomed into their home. They talked and shared stories of

the school and offered us candy. We were able to leave them with a bunch of Butterscotch brownies that Emma had made. Good people a good visit."

It wasn't far but is was passed a closed and posted no trespassing sign and dilapidated

building. Then through an opening of some trees. It was by no means a road. I began to wonder what we were doing. We got out and there didn't seem to be anyone home. We were greeted by many No Trespassing Signs and dog warnings. I took a quick photo. The mother and son were very kind and they told us we should really be careful and not so trusting of people. Which was funny as it was crazy where we had just followed them to. They worried about us and asked if we wanted them to take us back to the highway. We thanked them and headed on our way. Pretty sure this is a school and it was indeed an adventure. It is hard to tell by this photo but there was one in Eminence, Kentucky Henry County which is where this was and it is listed on this street. However you won't know it was a street anymore because it is actually behind the street and through the trees."

There were signs saying Ruritan Club which I had never heard of at the time, however I have seen them more frequently now in the south. The wood and windows looked right for a Rosenwald as did the cloak room. Over the years that is one thing that many of the elders who went to the schools is the cloak rooms. This one had one as well and truly matched up."
