Abstract:

Judy Richardson is a veteran of the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee who worked in Mississippi during the Mississippi Freedom Summer Project in 1964. She later worked with Blackside, Inc., on the Eyes on the Prize civil rights documentary series, and co-edited Hands on the Freedom Plow, about women's experiences in SNCC. Her papers include materials from her years working on staff at SNCC in Atlanta and Mississippi; her involvement with the Drum and Spear Bookstore in Washington D.C.; extensive print and audiovisual materials from her work in documentary film, including projects like Malcolm X: Make It Plain, Eyes on the Prize, and Scarred Justice: The Orangeburg Massacre; her correspondence and drafts from the editing of Hands on the Freedom Plow; project and event files from numerous committees, speaking engagements, and panels; personal files, including her FOIA about her SNCC service in the 1960s; and subject files collected from various projects.

Background

Scope and Content

The Judy Richardson Papers include materials from her years working on staff at SNCC in Atlanta and Mississippi; her involvement with the Drum and Spear Bookstore in Washington D.C.; extensive print and audiovisual materials from her work in documentary film, including projects like *Malcolm X: Make It Plain*, *Eyes on the Prize*, and *Scarred Justice: The Orangeburg Massacre*; her correspondence and drafts from the editing of *Hands on the Freedom Plow*; project and event files from numerous committees, speaking engagements, and panels; personal files, including her FOIA about her SNCC service in the 1960s; and subject files collected from various projects.

Materials are arranged into series based on format and topic. The *Hands on the Freedom Plow Series* is closed until 2020. Original audiovisual materials are closed to use.

Biographical/Historical

Judy Richardson was born in Tarrytown, New York, and attended Swarthmore College before joining the civil rights movement in 1963. She worked for the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee from 1963 to 1966, with posts in Atlanta, Mississippi, and Alabama. She worked for the Mississippi Freedom Summer Project and also coordinated the operation of a Residential Freedom School in 1965.

Richardson then joined the staff of the Drum and Spear bookstore in Washington, D.C., and spent several years serving as its children's editor and director (1968-1972). During the 1970s she also founded and managed the Maelezo Bookstore (1972-1973), worked for and later directed the Black Student Fund (1973-1977), and meanwhile took college courses at both Howard University and Columbia University. She eventually earned a degree in children's literature from Antioch College (1977).

Richardson joined Blackside, Inc., in 1978, becoming an advisor and then associate producer of *Eyes on the Prize I and II*, an award-winning PBS series on the civil rights movement. She also co-produced Blackside's *Malcolm X: Make It Plain*, another documentary. In 1982, she began working for the United Church of Christ's Commission for Racial Justice, writing commentaries and serving as its Director of Information from 1984 until 1989. Richardson worked for Blackside until 1999, serving as producer and education director. In

2001, she joined Northern Light Productions, and produced several historical documentaries and educational films.

Richardson co-edited *Hands on the Freedom Plow: Personal Accounts by Women in SNCC*, which was published by University of Illinois Press in 2010. She became a distinguished visiting professor at Brown University in 2012.

Scope and Contents

This series includes drafts, edits, and correspondence between Richardson, her fellow editors, and the book's contributors over the ten years of work prior to the publication of *Hands on the Freedom Plow: Personal Accounts by Women in SNCC* (published in 2010 by University of Illinois Press). The materials have been arranged into three subseries: Drafts/Editing; Publication; and Correspondence.

Drafts/Editing includes work by the volume's six editors: Faith S. Holsaert, Martha Prescod Norman Noonan, Judy Richardson, Betty Garman Robinson, Jean Smith Young, and Dorothy M. Zellner. All of the editors are SNCC veterans who solicited contributions from other women who joined the SNCC organization during the civil rights movement. The subseries includes name files for each contributor, including several contributors who were not published in the final version of the volume. The files typically include both the original and subsequent drafts written by each author for *Hands*. This subseries also includes the editors' work in writing introductions and transitions between each segment and chapter of the text.

The Publications subseries largely consists of marketing and publicity files leading up to and following the book's publication in 2010.

The Correspondence subseries includes Richardson's copies of exchanges between the editors, the contributors, and the publishers of the volume. Typically these are Richardson's email printouts, occasionally accompanied by personal notes or drafts of emails.

SNCC and Civil Rights Movement, 1963-1970

Scope and Contents

This series contains Richardson's original documents from the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC) and other civil rights organizations, including the Council of Federated Organizations (COFO) and the Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party. Files are arranged into three subseries: SNCC, the Residential Freedom School, and Ralph Featherstone.

The SNCC subseries includes newsletters, internal memoranda, and official circulars from several SNCC offices, including the national office and the New York office. The subseries contains material from various SNCC initiatives and partnerships, such as the Mississippi Summer Project, the Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party, civil rights conferences and demonstrations, the Julian Bond senatorial campaign, Black Panther literature, informational brochures on voter registration and organizing, and other miscellaneous printed materials. It also includes materials documenting Richardson's involvement in the Mississippi Summer Project, the campus travellers program, and the Heart of Atlanta hotel sit-in demonstration.

The Residential Freedom School subseries includes Richardson's work on establishing, funding, and running a Residential Freedom School in Alabama during the summer of 1965. It includes correspondence, registration information, logistical and administrative files, and program evaluations for the school.

The Death of Ralph Featherstone subseries contains documents acquired and collected by Richardson following the purported assassination of Ralph Featherstone and William "Che" Payne in Maryland. Featherstone worked with Richardson at Drum and Spear Bookstore in Washington, D.C.
