Dr. Mab Segrest is a feminist writer, scholar, and activist who received her PhD from Duke University in 1979. She was born in 1949 in Tuskegee, Alabama and attended Huntingdon College from 1967 to 1971. Segrest is recognized for speaking and writing about sexism, racism, homophobia, classism, and other forms of oppression. Collection contains correspondence, activism, teaching, and writing files, as well as photographic and audiovisual materials that document Segrest's personal life, education, and professional life. ### **Scope and Content**

This collection documents Segrest's personal life, education, and professional life and is comprised of materials related to her family, activism, research, writings, teaching, and travel.

The collection also contains a typescript of Dorothy Allison's *Bastard out of Carolina*.

There are significant materials relating to Segrest's work with the following organizations: The NC Coalition for Gay and Lesbian Equality, North Carolinians Against Racist and Religious Violence (NCARRV), The Center for Democratic Renewal (CDR), The North Carolina Coalition for Gay and Lesbian Equality (NCCGLE), National Women's Studies Association (NWSA), The World Council of Churches/Urban Rural Mission (WCC/URM), and The National Women's Studies Association/Southern Women's Studies Association (NWSA/SWSA).

Where possible, Segrest's original folder titles have been retained.

### **Biographical/Historical**

Dr. Mab Segrest is a feminist writer, scholar, and activist who received her PhD from Duke University in 1979. She was born in 1949 in Tuskegee, Alabama and attended Huntingdon College from 1967 to 1971. Multiple generations of Dr. Segrest's family have lived in the Tuskegee area and influenced its history and development.

Segrest is recognized for speaking and writing about sexism, racism, homophobia, classism, and other forms of oppression. She has founded, served on the boards of, and consulted with a wide range of social justice organizations throughout her life. From its creation in 1969 until it disbanded in 1983, Segrest participated in the southern feminist writing collective *Feminary* working to produce the journal of the same name. After *Feminary* disbanded, she worked for six years (1983-1990) with North Carolinians Against Racist and Religious Violence (NCARRV), focusing much of her work on removing the Ku Klux Klan from North Carolina. She earned her livelihood from 1992-2000 as Coordinator of the Urban-Rural Mission (USA), part of the URM network of the World Council of Churches. After working full-time with various political organizations, Segrest returned to academia. From 2002 until 2014, Segrest worked at Connecticut College in New London, Connecticut. In 2004, Segrest

was appointed the Fuller-Matthai Professor of Gender & Women's Studies there. Her major published works include: *Living in a House I Do Not Own* (Night Heron Press, 1982), *My Mama's Dead Squirrel: Lesbian Essays on Southern Culture*, (Firebrand Books, 1985), *Memoir of a Race Traitor* (South End Press, 1994), *Born to Belonging: Writings on Spirit and Justice* (Rutgers University Press, 2002), and *Administrations of Lunacy* (The New Press, 2020).

#### Scope and Contents

The series is divided into two chronological subseries: Personal and Professional. In some cases, there is overlap of personal and professional content because of the nature of the relationships Segrest has had with many of her correspondents.

Personal correspondence includes letters written by members of the Segrest family; most were written to or by Dr. Segrest. Many of the letters to her natal family members address their reactions to her published works. There is also a significant amount of correspondence between Dr. Segrest and her friends and chosen family, including Barbara Culbertson, David Jolly, Ceci Gray, Marquita Seavey, Monica Raymond, Adrienne Rich, Catherine Moriai, Minnie Bruce Pratt, and others.

Professional correspondence includes letters to and from publishers and editors, letters to and from other writers discussing their work, and correspondence documenting her academic career.

The Teaching series includes material from Dr. Segrest's experiences teaching at Connecticut College, Duke University, Campbell University, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, the Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers Association, a minimum security men's prison, and other institutions.

Dr. Segrest began teaching at Connecticut College in 2002 as a Visiting Assistant Professor and Chair of the Gender and Women's Studies Department; during this time she commuted from Durham, NC to Connecticut regularly.

The Duke University subseries contains material regarding Dr. Segrest's involvement with the Women's Studies department.

Dr. Segrest briefly taught at Campbell University and was the faculty advisor for "Lyricist," a language arts publication.

Dr. Segrest led classes on Queer Southern Literature at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in the late 1990s.

The Various Institutions subseries contains assorted material from different institutions of learning that Dr. Segrest has been affiliated with.

The Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers' Association subseries reflects Dr. Segrest's time teaching English as a Second Language (ESL) in migrant labor camps in the 1980s.

Dr. Segrest taught a GED course in a minimum security men's prison in the 1980s.

The Personal Files subseries is mostly composed of calendars, planners, and journals belonging to Dr. Segrest. There are also letters of recommendation and non-specific personal budget information in the subseries.

### Scope and Contents

The subseries contained in the Activism series are arranged in descending order by amount of material, then chronologically where possible within each organizational subseries.

Dr. Segrest helped to form NCARRV (North Carolinians Against Racist and Religious Violence) in 1985 with Christina Davis-McCoy. The group focused on anti-Klan activity in the state.

In the mid-1990s, Dr. Segrest was involved with the North Carolina Coalition for Gay and Lesbian Equality (NCGLE).

WomonWrites is a retreat for female authors founded in 1979. Dr. Segrest was one of the chief organizers.

The Our South subseries contains materials related to Dr. Segrest's involvement in the group in the 1980s.

From its creation in 1969 until it disbanded in 1983, Segrest participated in the southern feminist writing collective Feminary working to produce the journal of the same name.

Dr. Segrest was on the board (1986-1997) of the Center for Democratic Renewal, which was founded in 1979 as the National Anti-Klan Network by C.T. Vivian and Anne Braden.

The National Women's Studies Association and the Southeastern Women's Studies Association subseries contain materials related to Dr. Segrest's work with those organizations.

Dr. Segrest was Coordinator (1992-2000) of the Urban Rural Mission, part of the World Council of Churches.

The Various Groups subseries reflect Dr. Segrest's involvement with many social justice and feminist causes throughout the course of her career.

The Conferences and Speeches subseries contains materials related to guest lectures, keynote addresses, and speeches that Dr. Segrest has given around the country, as well as information about conferences that she has attended (and in some cases helped to organize).
