Background

Scope and Content

Collection includes Snitow's teaching files and materials with an emphasis on her work in Eastern Europe, career files, research files, speeches, correspondence, diaries, journals, notebooks, subject files, materials documenting Snitow's involvement in various activist groups and organizations, feminist publications in Eastern European languages, Snitow's writings and publications, published and unpublished materials documenting women's studies, feminist theory and feminist movements, recorded interviews, Snitow's recorded speeches, recordings of Snitow's radio shows on WBAI, and films by feminist documentarian Carol Jacobsen.

Biographical/Historical

Ann Barr Snitow (1943-2019) was a feminist activist, writer, and professor of literature and gender studies at Eugene Lang College The New School for Liberal Arts. She was born in New York and graduated with a literature degree from Cornell in 1965. After pursuing doctoral studies in London, she returned to New York in 1969 and became involved with the feminist movement. In the early 1970s, she hosted the radio show *Womankind* on the WBAI. She began her teaching career in the Gender Studies department at Rutgers in 1972, where she spent ten years before leaving for The New School. From 1981-1992, she directed the monthly seminar *Sex, Gender, and Consumer Culture* at the New York Institute for the Humanities. Snitow taught and researched in Poland from the 1980s-2019.

Snitow was one of the founding members of many feminist activist groups including the New York Radical Feminists (1969), Committee for Abortion Rights and Against Sterilization Abuse (1977), No More Nice Girls (1981), Feminist Anti-Censorship Task Force (1984), Network of East-West Women (1991), with Katha Pollitt and Ellen Willis, and *Take Back the Future* (2002).

Among her publications, Snitow co/authored or co/edited the books *Radical Feminism* (1973), *Powers of Desire: The Politics of Sexuality* (1983), *The Feminist Memoir Project: Voices from Women's Liberation* (1998), *The Feminism of Uncertainty: A Gender Diary* (Duke Press, 2015), and *Visitors: An American Feminist in East Central Europe* (2020).
